project. (3-4 sentences)

### **Example annotated entry:**

Martin, Florence, et al. "Middle School Students' Social Media Use." Journal of Educational Technology & Society, vol. 21, no. 1, 2018, pp. 213–224. JSTOR, JSTOR, www.jstor.org/stable/26273881.

Martin, et al., professors at the University of North Carolina, Charlotte, conducted a study of 593 middle school children and their social media use. The children reported that they began social media accounts, like Instagram, SnapChat, and YouTube, at the average age of 9. 40% reported that their parents do not monitor their use of social media. These young children felt they were exposed to inappropriate content, pictures, and postings that did them harm. They reported being bullied, harassed, stalked, and shamed. Looking at social media made them feel inferior to the people, peers, celebrities they followed.

"Middle School Students' Social Media Use" will serve as an effective source for proving that social media exposure at a young age contributes to poor self-image, depression, and inferiority complex in teens. This article will also serve as proof that young children need guidance and restrictions to avoid damaging self-confidence.
